MONEY MATTERS- Now 10 weeks into this year of the church accounts, the current levels of income and expenditure are more transparent and indicate an expected financial short fall of approximately £10,000. This excludes any unexpected and unplanned income or expenditure. In order to mange this, we as a parish need to balance out this amount. You might be surprised to know that we could make good this budget shortfall if everyone to increase their present giving by just £1 each week. Please give this your careful and prayerful consideration.

ALL SAINTS CHURCH TIDY DAY, 14TH APRIL- We are coming into springtime and that tidying feeling is fast approaching! MAUNDY THURSDAY – Your clergy will attending the Chrism Eucharist at Norwich Cathedral on Maundy Thursday and invite you to join them at this very special service when they renew their ordination vows. The service begins at 11am so we will need to leave at 9am to make sure we arrive in plenty of time. Please let us know at the Rectory Office if you would like to go along - lifts are available. **ANNUAL PAROCHIAL CHURCH MEETING** – Our Annual Meeting will be held on the morning of Sunday 22nd April at 10am South Wootton Village Hall to be followed by a shared lunch. The morning will include a service of Holy Communion held in the Village Hall. The services that would have been held at All Saints Church on that day will be transferred to 29th April. Churchwardens, PCC members, and sidespeople are all elected at the APCM and various annual reports are given. This is a very important and encouraging date in the Church's year – please put the date in your diary.

JAMES HAWKSWORTH- As you know, Kings Lynn is full of secondary school age young people. As I go and visit various different churches, projects and schools the common feeling is that our young people don't have many places to go where they can let their hair down in a safe environment and that they lack aspiration. As a Church Army Evangelist working across the deanery of Lynn in partnership with the local churches, I want this to change. Part of my work is to raise awareness of missional needs in the area and to find support in prayer and financial giving to support this venture. LENT LUNCHES- We are holding our usual series of Lent Lunches on Fridays between the 16th February and 23rd of March. All the Lunches will start at 12.30pm and will consist of a basic meal of soup, bread and cheese. There is no fixed charge, but donations are welcome. No need to book, just turn up. The proceeds from the lunches will be split between the Nakwero project in Uganda and the Bishop of Norwich's Diocesan Lent Appeal, which this year is for enabling local mission in Simbai, a remote village in the western highlands of Papua New Guinea.
